There is no U4 Program for the Indoor Season. Children must be born in 2010 or prior to start playing Indoor soccer.

- 1 - for jersey deposit \$75 (cheque - will be destroyed if jersey is returned) (only for U8 and up)
- 1 - for volunteer deposit \$200 (cheque - will be destroyed if volunteer is fulfilled)

What does my Registration Fee's pay for?... Field rentals, Gym times, Trophies, Pictures, Tournaments, Soccer Association Fee's, Referees, Socks/shorts, Coach's Courses, First aid supplies, Soccer equipment (balls, nets, cones etc.)

You will be required to make and maintain the ice on two Ice Rinks in timely fashion. You will put all the lines and markings in for hockey, which includes the goal crease and goal line. You will have insurance and WCB coverage. You will also provide your own snow removal equipment. The rinks will be open Tuesday to Sunday weather permitting.
The hours of operation will be 4 to 9 PM Tuesday to Friday and 1 to 7 PM on Saturday and Sunday. Deadline to apply is Sept 10.
