You will have insurance and WCB coverage. You will also provide your own snow removal equipment. The rinks will be open Tuesday to Sunday weather permitting.

The hours of operation will be 4 to 9 PM Tuesday to Friday and 1 to 7 PM on Saturday and Sunday. Deadline to apply is Sept 10.
